**ADMINISTRATIVE DECISION AFFIRMED**  
**Adopt the Resource Management Strategy February 2016 Update**  
**as the long-term asset management strategy**

**Action:** Adopt the Administrative Decision dated February 1, 2016 regarding the above referenced long-term asset management plan without modification. This decision document, combined with the Administrative Decision dated February 1, 2016, constitutes the final decision on this matter, in accordance with 11 AAC 99.040.

**Notice under 11 AAC 99.050.** The Trust Land Office published the public notice of the decision to adopt the updated 2016 Resource Management Strategy as the updated long-term asset management strategy in the Anchorage Daily News on February 2, 2016, and distributed the notice to other interested public and private parties by way of the Trust Land Office and State of Alaska Department of Natural Resources websites.

**Summary of Comments:** No comments were received.

**Trust Authority Consultation:** The Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority Resource Management Committee was consulted on this matter on January 26, 2016 and the Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority Full Board was consulted on this matter on January 27, 2016.

**Modifications:** As no comments were received suggesting that the Administrative Decision dated February 1, 2016 should be substantively modified in any way to better serve the interest of the Trust and its beneficiaries, the Executive Director has determined that no change shall be made to that document.

**Final Decision of the Executive Director:** Considering all of the above, the Executive Director of the Trust Land Office hereby adopts the Administrative Decision dated February 1, 2016 as final.

**Reconsideration:** Persons who submitted timely written comments during the notice period that ended March 3, 2016, are eligible to request reconsideration of this final administrative decision under 11 AAC 99.060(b) within 20 calendar days after publication of the notice or receipt of the final decision, whichever is earlier. A request for reconsideration must be submitted in writing to the Executive Director. Before filing an appeal to the Superior Court under AS 44.62.560, a person must be eligible to request and must actually request reconsideration within the time specified above.

The Executive Director shall order or deny reconsideration within 20 calendar days after receiving the written request for reconsideration. If the Executive Director takes no action during the 20-day period following the request, the request is considered denied. Denial of a request for reconsideration is the final administrative decision for purposes of appeal to the superior court under AS 44.62.560.
